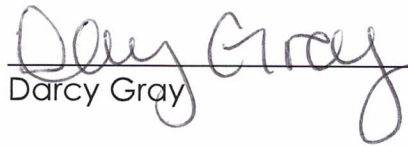

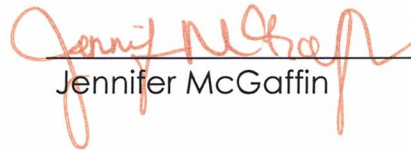

The special meeting of the Andale City Council is called to order by Mayor Martin at 7:03 p.m. on Monday, August 15, 2022. All Council members are present except for Cory Lies. The purpose of this meeting is to discuss funding for the Mt. Hope EMS, employee evaluations and pay raises, and the 2023 budget.

The Council discusses 2023 budget needs, including park improvements.

At 7:22 p.m. Cory Lies arrives and the Council begins the discussion on funding for the Mt. Hope EMS with its representatives - Shannon Brand, Matt Morris, and Tim Bryan. They are requesting a donation of \$7,500 from the City of Andale to help support their costs of responding to calls in the City. Ben Johnson moves to approve a \$7,500 donation to Mt. Hope EMS and Cory Lies seconds. The motion carries 5-0. The Council and Mt. Hope EMS will meet again at a later time to discuss future donations.

The Council resumes their discussion on the 2023 budget. At 8:25 p.m. Cory Lies moves to go to executive session for 25 minutes to discuss non-elect personnel matters and inviting in the City Attorney and Patty Hein, Chief Cook and Jeremy Martin at various times. Ben Johnson seconds and the motion carries 5-0.

At 8:50 p.m. Mayor Martin states that no binding action was taken in executive session and the regular session resumes.

At 8:52 p.m. Darcy Gray moves to go back to executive session for 30 minutes to discuss non-elect personnel matters and inviting in the City Attorney and Patty Hein, Chief Cook and Jeremy Martin at various times. Jennifer McGaffin seconds and the motion carries 5-0.

At 9:22 p.m. Mayor Martin states that no binding action was taken in executive session and the regular session resumes.

At 9:30 p.m. Cory Lies moves to go back to executive session for 15 minutes and inviting in the City Attorney and Patty Hein. Jennifer McGaffin seconds and the motion carries 5-0.

At 9:45 p.m. Mayor Martin states that no binding action was taken in executive session and the regular session resumes.

The Council continues the discussion on the 2023 budget.

At 10:22 p.m. Jennifer McGaffin moves to adjourn and Ben Johnson seconds. The motion carries 5-0.
