THE CITY OF ANDALE, KANSAS

ORDINANCE NO. 18-1

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ANDALE, KANSAS BY ESTABLISHING A TWENTY (20) MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT FOR ALL STREETS WITHIN RESIDENTIAL DISTRICTS OF THE CITY OF ANDALE, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has completed a traffic study of streets within the residential districts of the City of Andale, Kansas; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has determined it to be in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Andale, Kansas that the speed limit permitted for streets within the residential districts of the City of Andale, Kansas shall be twenty (20) miles per hour, unless otherwise legally posted within the City of Andale, Kansas, in accordance with K.S.A. 8-1560.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDALE, KANSAS:

Section 1. Speed Limit in Residential Districts

In accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 8-1560, the Governing Body of the City of Andale, Kansas hereby determines and declares that the speed limit permitted for streets in residential districts within its corporate limits is twenty (20) miles per hour, unless otherwise legally posted within the City of Andale, Kansas. Said speed limit is subordinate to all school zones properly established by ordinance.

Section 2. Repeal

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed. However, any section of an existing ordinance not in conflict herewith is not repealed and remains in full force and effect.

Section 3. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after publication in the

official city newspaper.
