**NOTICE OF SPECIAL QUESTION ELECTION
CITY OF ANDALE, KANSAS**

Notice is hereby given to the qualified electors of the City of Andale, Kansas (the "City") that a special question election has been called and will be held on November 3, 2026, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of the City the following proposition:

Shall the following be adopted?

Shall a retailers' sales tax in the amount of one percent (1.00%) be levied in the City of Andale, Kansas, to take effect April 1, 2027, or as soon thereafter as such tax may be levied by the Kansas Department of Revenue, with revenue from such tax used for the purposes of providing mill levy support, assistance in establishing a General Fund Stabilization Reserve, and for Parks, Sidewalks, Roads and other General Government Purposes, including payment of debt service on financings issued for such purposes; and provided that such retailers' sales tax shall expire on the date ten years after it is first levied, all pursuant to K.S.A 12-187, et seq., as amended?
