

RESOLUTION NO. 3-26

A RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF ANDALE, KANSAS, THE PROPOSITION OF LEVYING A ONE PERCENT (1.00%) RETAILERS' SALES TAX FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING LOCAL STREETS, PARKS & RECREATION IMPROVEMENTS, WITHIN THE CITY OF ANDALE, SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 12-187 *et seq.*, as amended (the "Act"), authorizes the governing body (the "Governing Body") of the City of Andale, Kansas (the "City") to submit to the electors of the City the question of imposing a Citywide retailers' sales tax, which may be in an amount not to exceed two-percent (2%) for general purposes or in an additional amount not to exceed one percent (1%) for special purposes, provided sales taxes for special purposes shall expire not later than ten (10) years from the initial date of collection thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body deems it advisable that additional funds, other than from ad valorem property taxation, be derived from a City-wide sales tax for the purposes of providing mill levy support, assistance in establishing a General Fund Stabilization Reserve, and for Parks, Sidewalks, Roads and other General Government Purposes, including payment of debt service on financings issued for such purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body hereby further deems it advisable to provide for an additional source of revenue to finance such purposes by the imposition of a Citywide retailers' sales tax; provided the electors of the City authorize such sales tax at an election held in the City for such purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body deems it advisable to provide for the calling of a special question election in the City for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of the City the question of imposing a one percent (1%) Citywide retailers' sales tax (the "Sales Tax"); and

WHEREAS, in order to authorize such Sales Tax, it is deemed advisable to call a special question election in the City on November 3, 2026; and

WHEREAS, if approved, the Sales Tax will constitute a sales tax imposed for general purposes, as said term is described in K.S.A. 12-189, as amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDALE, KANSAS:

Section 1. A special question election is called to be conducted on November 3, 2026, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of the City the question of levying a retailers' sales tax in the City in the amount of one percent (1.00%), with such tax to take effect April 1, 2027, if such special question is approved by a majority of the electors voting on the question. The election shall be conducted in the manner prescribed by applicable laws of the State of Kansas.

Section 2. If approved by a majority of the electors voting on the question, the retailers' sales tax will be subject to all applicable state laws and administrative rules and regulations of the Kansas Department of Revenue. The services of the Kansas Department of Revenue shall be utilized in conformance with K.S.A. 12-189, and all other applicable laws of the State of Kansas.

Section 3. The proposition to be voted on shall appear on the ballot as follows:

Shall the following be adopted?

Shall a retailers' sales tax in the amount of one percent (1.00%) be levied in the City of Andale, Kansas, to take effect April 1, 2027, or as soon thereafter as such tax may be levied by the Kansas Department of Revenue, with revenue from such tax used for the purposes of providing mill levy support, assistance in establishing a General Fund Stabilization Reserve, and for Parks, Sidewalks, Roads and other General Government Purposes, including payment of debt service on financings issued for such purposes; and provided that such retailers' sales tax shall expire on the date ten years after it is first levied, all pursuant to K.S.A 12-187, et seq., as amended?

Section 4. The Sedgwick County Election Commissioner is hereby authorized to and shall give notice of the election by publishing a Notice of Election once each week for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in the City, as provided in K.S.A. 12- 187 et seq., and K.S.A. 10-120, with the first publication to be not less than twenty-one (21) days prior to the date of the election. The vote at the election shall be by ballot and the proposition approved by this Resolution shall be printed on the ballot with the voting instructions required by law.

Section 5. This Resolution shall be effective from and after its adoption.
